What is the commitment?

The Board of Directors meets 5 times per year (bi-monthly) plus an AGM in the fall. In addition Directors may be asked to sit on sub-committees based on their area of expertise.

At this time during COVID the meetings are held virtually, currently on a Wednesday evening at 7pm and last approximately 1.5 – 2 hours depending on the amount of discussion required.

Directors are responsible for representing the interests of the organization. When directing the affairs of an organization, the board must act within the law. As a trustee, a board member must follow four basic principles:

1. **Diligence.** Act reasonably and in good faith. Consider the best interest of the organization and its members.
2. **Loyalty.** Place the interest of the organization first. Don't use your position to further your personal interests.
3. **Obedience.** Act within the scope of the law. Follow the rules and regulations that apply to the organization.
4. **Inclusive.** PSVI hosts an inclusive environment in which all individuals are treated fairly and respectfully, have equal access to opportunities and resources, and can contribute fully to the organization's success.
